Hours per day: 2

Supervisor: Rector

Please contact your supervisor in the first instance if you wish to discuss any volunteer related matters or issues that may arise.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintain a safe environment for all participants
- Ensure a child safe environment with adequate child to adult ratios
- Undertake training relevant to the role
- Supervise and train playgroup helpers
- Be aware of mandatory reporting obligations and adhere to these.
- Manage the building set up for children's activities, and return the building to its previous set up after use (including clean up)
- Communicate regularly with your supervisor, reporting any concerns in a timely fashion
- Support and implement a programme of activities relevant to the age and ability of the group members and the context of the children's ministry
- Engage with children and their parents in appropriate activities and ensure adults are not alone with a child other than their own
- Know and pray for specific children's and family needs
- Other duties as required by the incumbent, that are within the capabilities of the volunteers 'skills and experience
- Ability to work in a team and under the direction of the rector/priest in charge/locum priest if applicable
- Adhere to the Parish Safety Policy and the Dioceses' commitment to the NSW child safe standards
